





Core Curriculum:

Every student will take English Language. English Literature, Maths, Combined Science, a Language and PE as well as three subjects (one from each block) from the option blocks A,B & C below.

- This means that the majority of students will study a broad core of traditional academic subjects (known as the EBacc) which we believe will fully prepare them for entry into higher education and eventually the competitive work!


The Virgin Group will no longer ask job candidates about their exam results, Sir Richard Branson has announced.










Augmented and Virtual Reality
