Core Curriculum:

Every student will take English Language, English Literature, Maths, Combined Science, a Language and PE as well as three subjects (one from each block) from the option blocks A,B & C below.

However

- Most students **will have to choose at least one Humanities**.
- This means that **the majority of students** will study a broad **core of traditional academic** subjects (known as the **EBacc**) which we believe will fully prepare them for entry into higher education and eventually the competitive world of work.
